Bridget Beari Designs

Susan Jamieson of Bridget Beari Designs wanted a space where she could showcase her Bridget Beari wallpaper line. In the foyer and upstairs hall she demonstrates the many ways wallpaper can be used: It's a vertical design used horizontally. It's used on stair risers. The pattern is blown up. It's applied to the ceiling. "It was very technically challenging," she says, "but I think

we achieved a very dramatic effect." Designer house visitors asked, "Is it stenciled? Is it painted?" according to Jamieson. The space also features a chandelier of Jamieson's design. The chandelier, fabricated by Doug McDonald, comprises 1,800 feet of gold chain and dramatically illuminates the 25-foot space with LED lighting. Artist Ryan Golthrup created the large glass floor vases.

Commonwealth Curb Appeal

Using Belgard concrete pavers and wall stones and staging the space in partnership with Summer Classics. Josh Goff of Commonwealth Curb Appeal designed an intimate courtyard, where a couple can relax in front of the gas fireplace with the open sky above. His planters feature purple fountain grass, petunias and golden weeping speedwell. The stone fireplace has lanterns built into it. "Thefireplace takes up so much room, the lanterns help bring it back into proportion and tie everything in," Goff says.
